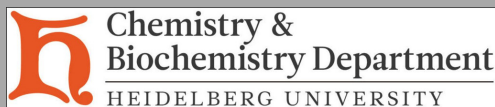
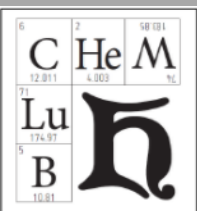

The NCWQR is responsible for chemical analysis of freshwater samples, biological assessment of aquatic communities, and watershed modelling. This information is used in order to understand and interpret the impact of things such as food production on soil and water resources, the status of local water quality, the effects of water quality on ecosystem health, and even studies future implications for the availability of healthy usable water.
