

Toledo Section ACS Hands-On SUMMER 2018 OUTREACH

FINAL REPORT

I organized 12 different FREE Summer Hands-on Outreach Programs for summer 2018 and reached nearly 550 youth and adults; most from economically disadvantaged households.

- 3 Events were held at branch libraries were part of Toledo Lucas County Public Library Summer Reads Program.
- 7 Events were coordinated with Toledo Lucas County Parks and Recreation and Toledo Youth Commission and held at 7 different parks participating in the Ohio Summer Food Service Program: Kids Eat Here FREE.
- 1 program (STEAM DAY) was coordinated with Community Learning Centers, Wood County Educational Service Center and was held down at BGSU Field House.
- 1 program was held at Redeemer Lutheran Church on Upton Ave as part of the Ohio Summer Food Service Program: Kids Eat Here FREE.

Summary of events with dates, locations, number of attendees, and names of volunteers for each event is given below; also a tally of total volunteer hours is provided.

Per my email of June 6, 2018, I itemized a budget allowance of \$150.00 for summer outreach. At that time I had not made a commitment for program at Redeemer Lutheran Church.

My final expenses for consumable materials amounted to \$124.07. I have a few remaining items. Original receipts for purchases will be mailed to Treasurer Nate Beres.

I used supplies I already had in addition to re-using most plastic cups. I also provided and reused many bottles from my own recycling bin.

University of Toledo stock room was kind enough to loan a stir plate, many child size goggles; plus gave me about 150 g of sodium acetate trihydrate.

I displayed the section banner at majority of events.

Youth and adults were instructed and reminded regularly to wear goggles during the event.

I recruited volunteers via email from toledosectionacs@gmail.com . They were very PROTON-like !

All volunteers were thanked in person, by email and also mailed thank you cards. Some were also given a Toledo Section ACS button if they did not already have one. And some enjoyed a piece or 2 of Laffy Taffy when we were using those.

NOTE: I would like to be able to provide regular and repeat volunteers with a Toledo Section ACS Outreach t-shirt as a thank you gift (plus encourage them to wear it at our outreach events). I'm willing to personally cover/donate a significant part of the expense; and am wondering if the section might be willing to put some money towards this effort (probably come out of miscellaneous outreach budget). The section might also consider selling some t-shirts if we print extra. I am investigating the expense for this using a local company that made the Chem-tenial shirts for us. I will follow-up with a proposal and formal request to EC.
